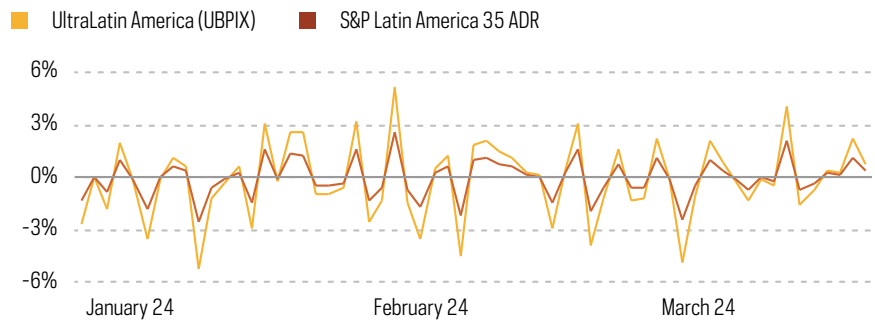

Common uses for magnified exposure include:



- Seeking magnified gains (will also magnify losses)
